



Group Camping at Pelican Point

South Carlsbad State Beach

General Information

South Carlsbad State Beach has year-round Group Camping available for approved groups at the northern most portion of the campground known as Pelican Point. The bluff top site offers picnic tables, a fire ring, and is close to restroom and shower amenities. The location offers parking for up to 8 passenger vehicles.

Rules of Pelican Point

- No alcohol allowed at the site.
- Approved groups must hire a lifeguard if any portion of the group will be participating in water activities.
- Trash removal and clean-up is the responsibility of the group. All trash must be disposed of in the dumpsters at check-out.
- All campers must remain off of the wooden deck.
- No tents/chairs/bikes/scooters on wooden deck.
- 1 trailer is allowed in the site with permit approval. No other outside vehicles are allowed in the site at any time.
- Any damage to the deck or site will be at the cost of the group.

Directions

I-5 Freeway to Poinsettia Lane. Exit Poinsettia and go west. Make a right at Carlsbad Blvd. Make a u-turn at the next stoplight. Campground will be on your right. Pelican Point is at the northern end of the campground.

Parking

There are 8 designated parking spaces within the campground for Pelican Point. These vehicles are included in the group camping fees. Any vehicles not able to park within the campground may park in the street-side **day-use** parking lot on Carlsbad Blvd.

Emergencies

After the park is closed, emergencies are handled by the camp host. The camp hosts are located in the campground lot #98 and #127. They are trained and will call the appropriate agency.

Group Camping Fees

1-25 people.....\$175.00 per night
26-50 people.....\$225.00 per night

A Special Event Permit is also needed for group camping. The Special Event Permit is \$75 and non-refundable.

Check In & Check Out Times

Check-in time for the group camp area is 2:00PM on the due-in date. Check-out time is 12:00PM on the due-out date. Please make sure to return the campsite to its original condition and remove all trash to appropriate areas.

Campground Hours

Campground operating hours are from dawn to sunset. However, the quiet hours of the campground are between 10:00PM and 6:00AM. Please respect these quiet hours and the other campers around your site.
